A Lynchburg man will serve 38 years in prison for his role in a home-invasion robbery last year that left another man dead.

Joseph Lee Hamlet, 24, testified Friday that he didn't know he and two other men were going to rob 26-year-old David Devin Poe at his Early Street house when the trio left a party the night of June 11, 2006.
