**Man pleads
guilty in car
break-ins**

years, eight months**

A man accused of carrying out a rash of car break-ins throughout a number of area neighborhoods in January pleaded guilty Monday in Lynchburg Circuit Court.

Anton Shantae Buckner, 26, of Lynchburg, pleaded guilty to eight counts of tampering with a vehicle and two counts of petit larceny, said Deputy Commonwealth's Attorney Chuck Felmlee in an email Monday.

Following a plea agreement, Buckner was sentenced to two years and eight months.

He currently is serving his sentence in the Blue Ridge Regional Jail.

Felmlee said Buckner terrorized several Lynchburg apartment complexes — including the New Towne development off
