A Lynchburg woman accused of taking money from prostitutes in exchange for allowing them to ply their trade in her bedroom was sentenced to three months in jail Friday morning in Lynchburg Circuit Court.

Patricia Bolen, 59, formerly of the 1500 block of Gar-

field Avenue, was convicted of three counts of attempting to receive money from the earnings of a female prostitute.
