

# City man sentenced to 6 years in beating

A Lynchburg man with a history in the local justice system was sentenced to six years in prison Monday in a home-invasion beating case.

Deputy Commonwealth's Attorney Chuck Felmlee said 34-year-old Timothy Hunter Paige

broke into the home of Christiandior Cruz in the 800 block of Early Street last spring and beat the woman with a metal rod.



**Timothy Hunter Paige**, 34, of Lynchburg, pleaded guilty to statutory burglary, unlawful wounding and a probation violation.

Felmlee told Lynchburg Circuit Court Judge Patrick Yeatts that Cruz would have testified she had been buying cocaine and

carrying on a sexual relationship with Paige at the time, but didn't invite him over on April 27.
